Carolynn briefly shared information about our ARMA chapter and our monthly meetings, the upcoming November meeting info, the merger of ARMA and the Information Coalition organization, and the ARMA App.

Suzie and Gabe started off with a presentation overview of the TMC. They are a group dedicated to reviewing and making decisions about the roads across the state. They manage the variable speed limits, control the information displayed on the board, and decide, based on a wide range of information, when to close the roads. Here are some additional information

- Manage 18 TB of data per year and climbing
- The Connected Vehicle program contains 53.3 TBs for I-80
- They keep records for a minimum of 2 years. This is used to review information and trends
- They get various requests from law enforcement, trucking companies and lawyers

They are also in charge of the Wyoming 511 mobile app that keeps you up to date on the road conditions. They recently added an update to the app to allow end users to submit pictures and information regarding the road conditions
